

Camp out at Christian Disciple Festival

The Christian Disciple Festival is a unique immersion experience designed to work in conjunction with The Christian Disciple Farm. The festival takes place at The Jefferson County Fair Park, August 2nd-8th. It is designed primarily for youth & young adults (ages 14-24), although all ages are welcome.

COST—\$180 covers lodging, all meals and activities for 6 nights. (\$30/day).

This is a great opportunity for volunteers to participate in a very rewarding program. Due to the outdoor setting of this camp and the special needs of the children there is a large need for volunteers. One of the most rewarding jobs is being a "buddy" to a child with special needs. The day camp takes place Monday through Friday from 9AM to 2:30PM at Raspberry Hill Farm. This is a private farm located about halfway between Madison and Milwaukee near the town of Sullivan. It has 41 beautiful acres of woods, fields and a fishing pond. Lunch is provided daily for campers and volunteers. There is no cost to volunteer at the camp, however, if you stay overnight with the other volunteers at The Jefferson County Fair Park there is a fee (explained on the back of the brochure).
